*The craft fee will help cover the cost of some of our classroom experiments and sensory play items. Please plan to pay this fee with cash.

**A rest mat will be needed for school. To remain consistent and meet the needs of the classroom, we ask that you purchase a quilted rollable mat with pillow and blanket attached. Amazon has many choices for this type of mat.

***Please make sure your child's name is on his/her rest mat, water bottle, lunch box, folder, and book bag.

At the start of school our Family School Association also collects a fee to help with the different activities and parties we have throughout the year. If you would like to pay this fee at the supply drop off as well, the amount is \$30. Please plan to pay this in cash as well.
