HEALTH INFORMATION: A few infections have been going around our school and others in the area so we wanted families to be informed as they are highly contagious. They can spread easily among children in close settings, like schools.

- Head lice are small, parasitic insects that can infest the hair and scalp. It is NOT a communicable disease and no health risks have been associated with it. We would like for you to just keep an eye on your child's head and look for itchy scalp or other lice symptoms. This is treated with an over the counter shampoo and knit combing.
- Hand, foot, and mouth disease is a common viral infection that causes painful blisters in the mouth, hands, feet, and sometimes buttocks. Watch for fever, sore throat, blisters in the mouth, hands, feet, and/or buttocks, which are common symptoms. Please contact your doctor for advice.
