

### Monday, Dec. 15th - Elf Richards is back! Make sure you are on time to see where she is!

- ❖ It's the Blessing of the Bambinelli. We will be celebrating the Blessing of the Bambinelli during our Advent Service at Morning Announcements. We are asking that each student bring their baby Jesus from their family Manger to be blessed. Once Jesus is blessed tradition says he is to be wrapped in Christmas paper and placed under the Christmas tree. On Christmas morning, he is the first gift to be opened. What a wonderful way to include Jesus and remind ourselves that Jesus is the reason for the season. Do not worry! Each child will be making a baby Jesus in school, just in case your family does not have one.
- ❖ It's also the school-wide "Jesus' Birthday Celebration" and Las Posadas! Children are asked to dress however they would if they were attending Jesus' Birthday party. The day will be filled with celebrating Jesus, the real meaning of Christmas. We will have cupcakes, sing "Happy Birthday", engineer gifts for the baby Jesus, and watch a movie.

## <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>Dec. 16th</u> - Christmas Program day
